

The *Easy* SAT-ACT Concordance Table

There are many different ways of comparing SAT and ACT scores. This is the easy way! **21 on an ACT section** is roughly equivalent to **500 on an SAT section**. A **1-point increase on an ACT section** is roughly equivalent to a **20-point increase on an SAT section**. Hence, an **ACT 26** is like an **SAT 600**; an **ACT 31** is like an **SAT 700**; and an **ACT 36** is like an **SAT 800**. That's how I derived the table above.
